### **14. BCP Surveys (212/22)**

Council to resolve to agree that the two surveys ,Green Infrastructure Strategy Engagement and Trees and Woodland Strategy Engagement , are completed by THVC, agreed by 3 Councillors, and submitted by the deadline date of the 5th December 2022 on the proviso that the responses are in the interest of the parish, factual and non-inflammatory.

### **15. Stour Valley Park update (213/22)**

Landstary were commissioned (£120K) by BCP/ Parks Foundation to conduct a survey for the development of the Stour Valley Park. Landstary has completed its work and handed its findings to BCP in February 2022 .

However, Landstary have not published their findings on the section between Longham and Iford, which includes THVC. This is clearly a major omission in this expensive survey.

Councillors to resolve to delegate the Clerk to write to BCP for the full Landstary report on the section Longham to Iford as this will impact on the response by THVC to the BCP Green and Woodland policy surveys.
